#### Itinerary

##### Day 1 Hong Kong

Depart Hong Kong International Airport.

Overnight on the flight.

##### Day 2 Windhoek

Arrive at Windhoek – the capital of Namibia

Visit the Xmama Cultural Village. Enjoy the local cuisine and national dance.

Photo-taking opportunity with the Oshiwambo tribe.

Enjoy the Windhoek city tour - a vibrant city dating back to the German colonial era

Overnight at Hotel Safari, Windhoek or similar (L/D)

##### Day 3 Mariental

Transfer to Mariental - the famous red sand dunes.

Capture the color change of the dune in the morning and evening,  
its beautiful curve, the blue sky and the white clouds into contrasting photos.

Bushman tribe photo-taking opportunity at the dune.

Overnight at Kalahari Farmhouse, Mariental or similar (B/L/D)

##### Day 4 Sossusvlei

Early morning 4X4 tour in the red sand dunes, perfect for nice sunrise photos.

Sossusvlei region is famous for its Namib desert.

It hosts the world's oldest sand desert with the world's highest sand dunes.

The infinite dunes are the source of inspiration for writers and photographers – full of primitive and rough scenery.

Overnight at Namib Desert Lodge or similar (B/L/D)

##### Day 5 Sossusvlei

Early departure at 0530 for photos of the dawn at the world's oldest desert and the world's highest dune.

Transferred to the desert region by 4X4. Visit dunes number 45 (up to 325 meters).

Different sources of light gives life to the dune forming its different unique appearance.

Visit Death Valley - desolate and broad, rugged and magnificent, consists of huge dry clay basin and thousands of dead wood. It is surrounded by many red sand dunes, like endless walls. There is no sign of living – not even a grass can survive.

This charming and amazing place on the planet is the dream land for most of the photographers.

Time permitted visit Sesriem Canyon. The canyon is 1 km long and 30-40 meters deep.

Overnight at Namib Desert Lodge or similar (B/L/D)

#### Day 6 Swakopmund

Going through the Gaub Pass, Kuiseb Canyon and Gravel Plains of the Namib Desert, you will soon arrive at Swakopmund. Enjoy the unique landscape along the road.

Swakopmund is located in the northwest of Namibia near the Atlantic Ocean. It is a seaside resort city.

The city stays right in the middle of the blue ocean and the golden dunes.

Scrolling under the palm trees on the promenade, you will understand the reason why Swakopmund is an international attractive resort.

Overnight at Hotel Europa Hof or similar (B/L/D)

#### Day 7 Swakopmund

Board the Walvis Bay cruise to explore the Atlantic Ocean.

The cold Atlantic waters of the Namib coast harbour a wealth of marine life, such as birds, seals and dolphin etc.

After lunch, enjoy the highlight of Swakopmund.

Try the popular sandwich tour with one side overseeing the ocean and the other side appreciating the red sand dunes. What a stunning experience!

Overnight at Hotel Europa Hof or similar (B/L/D)

#### Day 8 Twyfelfontein

Depart Swakopmund and drive through Henties Bay and Uis to Khorixas. Arrive at Twyfelfontein and visit the ancient rock carvings - the Bushman features on the wall.

Visit the Damara village for photo-taking opportunity.

After lunch, visit the village of Himba. Himba is a very strange tribes still maintaining the most primitive life.

It is mysterious and you would be shocked after knowing its livelihood and it is an unforgettable experience!

Overnight at Twyfelfontein Lodge or similar (B/L/D)

#### Day 9 Etosha

Visit the Etosha Wildlife Sanctuary for its wildlife on 4X4.

Etosha means a vast dry white earth. This dry basin embraced the world's largest animal protection forest.

It is the main wildlife sanctuary in Africa.



Since 1907, it was declared as a non-hunting region and covers an area of more than 22 750 square kilometers.

This is indeed one of the most distinctive African wildlife sanctuaries - very rich in ecology: 150 species of mammals, 340 species of birds and countless reptiles and insects, including some rare and endangered species such as black rhinoceros.

Overnight at Toshari Lodge or similar (B/L/D)

Day 10 Etosha

Prepared for another day visit to the Etosha Wildlife Sanctuary for its wildlife on 4X4

During the dry season, different wildlife would gather around the water hole, which is a precious scene for good pictures.

Overnight at Toshari Lodge or similar (B/L/D)

Day 11 Windhoek

After breakfast, pack your lunch box and prepare for the long drive back to the city - Windhoek

Overnight at Hotel Safari, Windhoek or similar (B/L/D)

Day 12 Windhoek

Transfer to Windhoek airport. Take the international flight back to Hong Kong.

Overnight on the plane.

Day 13 Hong Kong

Arrive at Hong Kong
